Dear dance students and parents,

As we approach the May 19 and May 20 dance performances, I would like to share information about purchasing recital tickets, the rehearsal and performance schedule, and other recital related items.

Recital Tickets are available for sale beginning Tuesday, April 18 and may be purchased at the Shenandoah University box office. The cost of a recital ticket is \$8.50 per ticket. You will be purchasing reserved seating. All children regardless of age must have a ticket. Inform the box office at the time of purchase if you have a visitor attending with a wheelchair, walker or special needs. Tickets may be purchased in person, by phone or online.

DRESS REHEARSAL & PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE: Attached is the rehearsal and performance schedule. Attendance at dress rehearsals is free and open to an unlimited number of guests and family members. This is the **best** opportunity you will have to videotape your student. Dress rehearsals will take place during the week of May 15-18. Rehearsals are located on Shenandoah University main campus at the Ohrstrom-Bryant Theatre.

VIDEOTAPING/PHOTOGRAPHY: Videotaping and photography by camera, hand-held phones or tablets is permitted **ONLY** during dress rehearsals and prohibited during the performances.

CONCERT ETIQUETTE: Please do not leave during the performance as it interrupts those around you and may prohibit them from seeing their student. Be respectful of those around you by leaving your phone dark and silent during the performance. We appreciate your cooperation.

DANCE PORTRAITS: This year, we will have KENSIE M PHOTOGRAPHY available for individual or group photos. The photographer's information is attached to this packet. If you are planning to have portraits taken, the photos need to be taken **AFTER** your child's dress rehearsal or on a day other than your child's scheduled dress rehearsal. Please see the attached photographer's packet for available portrait times.

PARKING: Please arrive early if you require a handicap parking space. Parking is available in the lots surrounding the theatre, and the parking garage to the left of the Armstrong Concert Hall entrance of the University, which is a short walk to the theatre.

We are very fortunate to be able to offer our students the experience and excitement of performing in the University's Ohrstrom-Bryant Theater.
